Where exactly is Air Atlanta Helicopters?

We are located on DeKalb-Peachtree Airport (PDK) in Atlanta. The physical street address for your GPS is 1951 Airport Road, Atlanta, GA 30341. When you turn onto Airport Road we are located in the first brick building on the right-hand side of the street. You'll notice a white awning at the top of the stairs with our logo on it.

What should I wear?

Simple answer – whatever you're comfortable wearing. Just keep in mind you'll be outside some of the time and climbing into and out of a helicopter, so short skirts and heels are not recommended for ladies.

Can I take pictures?

Absolutely! We want you to have something to remember this amazing experience and share it with your family and friends.

Can I bring my family and friends?

Of course – who better to share your helicopter experience? We invite you to bring up to 2 additional people to ride along in the rear seats of our Robinson R44 helicopter so you can impress them with your flying skills as they snap pictures and enjoy the view. There is a \$150 additional charge for 2 additional passengers.

How long is the flight portion of the Discovery Flight Experience?

You can expect to be in the area for approximately 30 minutes. If you would like to extend your flight please let us know when making your reservation and we'll be happy to accommodate you.

Can I extend my flight time?

Yes! Most people enjoy flying the helicopter so much they want to keep going. When making your reservation please let us know about any flight time extensions so we can accommodate you. An extra charge will apply to additional flight time.

Where will I fly to?

Our headquarters are centrally located to the Buckhead and Perimeter areas of Atlanta, so instructors generally maintain a course within this vicinity. If you have somewhere in particular you'd like to fly over, please let us know when making your reservation.

How safe is the helicopter?

Your safety is our primary goal. Air Atlanta Helicopters prides itself on completing 30,000 flight hours with no accidents or incidents – and we plan to keep it that way. All of our helicopters carry insurance, proper FAA certification, and are meticulously maintained by our experienced in-house maintenance staff.

How much experience does my instructor have?

All of our instructors have logged over 1,000 hours in rotorcraft flight. Each has undergone rigorous training and is always available to provide information and guidance. Instructors at Air Atlanta Helicopters are committed to maintaining high standards of excellence and a genuine interest in the safety and success of students.

What if it rains?

Rain, wind, thunder and lightning . . . oh my! Unfortunately the weather in Atlanta is completely out of our control, but we will make every effort to complete your flight in accordance with flight safety weather guidelines. Don't worry about the 10-day forecast. We receive special aviation radar reports every 12 hours to provide the most accurate outlook on flying conditions possible, and we won't reschedule your reservation until the day of your flight.

Not to worry. For our more powerfully built students we offer the solution of upgrading to our Schweizer 300Cbi helicopter for only \$35.
